

Self-Isolation Home Learning

Dear parents,

As we've had to self-isolate the year 4 bubble, this document will outline our **Remote Learning** process for the next 2 weeks to ensure that with your support, children are able to continue their learning from home.

In line with government guidance, we will aim to use a curriculum sequence that allows access to high-quality online and offline resources and teaching videos which are linked to the school's curriculum expectations. Printed resources, such as textbooks and workbooks, will be available for pupils who do not have suitable online access

Online platforms for remote learning



We will continue to communicate directly with you through Class Dojo.

Google Classroom & Purple Mash are online tools to share work and communicate with the pupils. Please help by making sure that your child logs in to these platforms. Remember that you can request a printed pack that can be used alone or alongside the online learning resource.

We understand the challenges this situation creates for you, so we will start off by suggesting a **timetable** involving 4 lessons everyday including Maths, Destination Reader, Learning Across the Curriculum and 1 other lesson from Science, PSHE, RE, PE and Art.

Morning 'Meet and greet': We would like to suggest a check in on Google Classroom at **9:00 am** every day for a brief 'Meet and greet' session, an outline of the day's planned activities and an opportunity to answer questions the children have.

Maths	We follow the White Rose Maths scheme of learning. White Rose has continued to produce daily 'home learning' lessons for Years 1-6. Every lesson comes with a short video showing parents clearly and simply how to help their child complete the activity successfully. The accompanying worksheet will be uploaded on Google Classroom. Children to use Mathletics to practise maths skills.
Learning Across the Curriculum	A pdf of the focus topic which will include content for the children to read and the task to complete will be uploaded daily.
Destination Reading	Purple Mash 2Do reading activities will be set daily including a chapter of the chosen book, activities linked to the book. Books will be set at the children reading levels. Children also have a reading book from the school which they should continue to read at home and record comments in their reading records.
Other subjects	Pdf with information on other lessons will also be uploaded on the day. Activities may be set as 2Dos in Purple Mash as well linked to topics.

Feedback will be provided to pupils for work handed in online through Google Classroom or Purple Mash. You can upload photographs of your child's work to Class Dojo.

The expectation is that the work is completed in the Homework book / online unless your child is unwell, in that case, please informs the school office.
