In the meantime, I would like to remind all parents/ carers of the following:

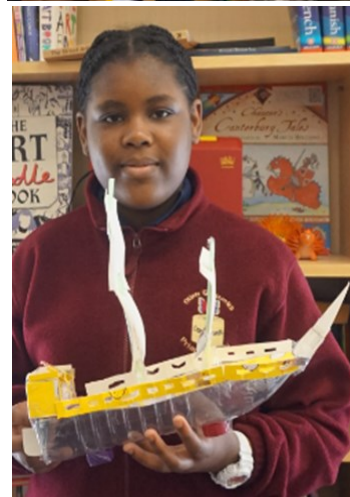
- Please be sure to wear a face mask when on the school grounds, unless medically exempt.

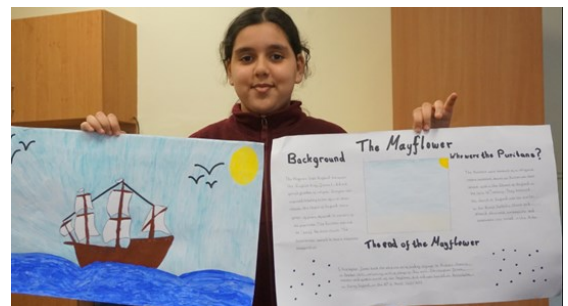
